- ◆ Two teenagers are dead and 17 other people were wounded after a shooting at a Kentucky high school Tuesday Morning. The suspect is a 15-year-old male student who was taken into custody.
- Prosecutors are seeking the death penalty against a suspected serial killer in Tampa who is accused of shooting and killing four people between Oct. 9 and Nov. 14, causing widespread fear in the Seminole Heights neighborhood.
- ◆ Immigration activists were outraged with Democrats on Monday night after party leadership agreed to a short-term funding bill.
- ◆ Tsunami warnings were issued early Tuesday morning along the south coast of Alaska and the western edge of British Columbia after a 7.9 magnitude earthquake occurred about 175 miles south of Kodiak. There have been no reports of damage since the quake.
