◆ HOUSE FIRE VICTIM DIES

An 84-year-old woman has died as a result of injuries she received last Wednesday night in a house fire at 721 East Madison Avenue in Athens. Mamie "Lucille" Floberg died late Thursday night at Vanderbilt Burn Center in Nashville. Her son, 48-year-old Mark Floberg, remains hospitalized in stable condition.

◆ SHOOTING SUSPECT IS IN CUSTODY

The suspect in the shooting of the night clerk at the Athens Lodge on Easter morning has been arrested. Athens police say 19-year-old Treaven Moses turned himself in at the Bradley County Sheriff's Department and was later transferred to the McMinn County Jail. He faces charges of attempted aggravated robbery. The night clerk at the motel says he went outside for a smoke and was approached by two males and a young female. He says one of the men grabbed him by the shoulder and pulled a handgun. The clerk says he tried to knock the gun downward when it discharged. The bullet struck him in the leg.
