- ◆ On Tuesday, a federal judge in New York ordered Iran to pay billions of dollars to parents, spouses, siblings and children of more than 1,000 9/11 victims. The default judgment finds the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps and the Central Bank of the Islamic Republic of Iran liable for the deaths of 1,008 people whose families sued.
