◆ INGLESIDE POOL TO OPEN SOON

The Athens Parks Department announces the opening of the Ingleside Pool on Thursday, May 24th, at 12:15 p.m. with the annual Pools-In/Schools-Out day with free admission to all attendees. Pool hours will be Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday from 12:15 p.m. to 6:45 p.m. Wednesdays hours will be 12:15 to 5:45 p.m., and Sunday the pool will be open from 1 to 5:45 p.m. Pool rates are \$2 for swimmers under 18 and senior citizens 55 and over. The rate for adults 18 and older is \$3. Patrons 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Patrons ages 10-15 who can swim, can pass a swim test given by the lifeguards, and have a liability release form signed by a parent or legal guardian do not have to be accompanied by an adult. The pool will be open until August 6th.

- ◆ A Knoxville-based internet security firm has determined there was an active attack on the Knox County website on May 1st during the county's primary election. The firm found IP addresses that were probing the servers were from 65 foreign countries including the Ukraine.
- ◆ Athens police are investigating the theft of a generator from the Let's Read 20 bus, which serves as a mobile library. The colorful bus is parked next to Athens City Middle School. Last Wednesday, thieves stole a generator worth \$4500 from the bus.
