- ◆ Ten more homes in the path of Hawaii's Kileaua volcano eruption have been destroyed by fast-moving lava. At least 51 homes have been destroyed since the volcanic emergency began. More than 2,000 people have fled the area.
- ♦ An historic expedition is scheduled for next Tuesday when long-distance swimmer Ben Lecomte begins a 5,500-mile swim across the Pacific Ocean starting in Japan and swimming to San Francisco. The journey is expected to take six to eight months, and is being tracked by Seeker, a digital media science company, and the Discovery Channel.
- ♦ Alberto, the first named subtropical storm of the 2018 season, has made landfall on the Florida panhandle, with heavy rain, gusty winds and flash flooding.
