◆ California residents will get a chance to vote on a measure to divide the Golden State into three separate states in the Nov. 6 general election. Proponents of the CAL 3 initiative submitted more than 402,468 valid signatures as of Tuesday.

◆ Six people were rescued Monday morning off the coast of Florida after the family's pontoon boat got caught in a storm and began sinking. They were approximately three miles south of the Seven Mile Bridge in Marathon, Florida.


