◆ LANE CLOSINGS ON PARK STREET

AUB crews will replace an aging manhole on Park Street this week. Park Street traffic will be reduced to two lanes from White Street to Hill Street from 8:30 a.m. Wednesday until the work is finished on Thursday afternoon. Glendale Ave. will be completely closed from Park Street to Hill Street during the same time period. Traffic at the White St.-Park St. intersection is already snarled by the state's widening project on White Street. AUB's Wayne Scarbrough says the manhole work must be done now because TDOT crews are preparing to lay a sewer line down Glendale Ave. from Highway 30, and the line must tie into the AUB manhole.

- ◆ The suspect in a mass shooting that left two people dead at a Madden 19 e-games tournament in Jacksonville, Florida, on Sunday, carried two handguns and extra ammunition into the contest venue and specifically targeted his competition. The two people killed in the shooting were considered the top two Madden gamers in the world. Twelve other people were wounded.
- ◆ Liberty Island and the Statue of Liberty were evacuated Monday after an apparent construction mishap sparked a fire in propane tanks. The blaze has since been extinguished but caused the National Parks Service to evacuate all 3,400 people from Liberty Island.
