♦ JUDGE GIVES TVA ACCESS TO MEIGS FARMS

Federal Judge Sandy Matice has signed an order giving TVA access to several farms along the route to a planned new \$300 million power center in Meigs County. The farm owners, meantime, have hired Chattanooga attorney Roger Dickson to try to fight TVA access to the farms for construction of a high-voltage line. One suit is in behalf of Greg Vital, a well-known businessman who has raised objections to the line going across his Meigs County farm. His farm includes an old stone barn that is on the National Registry of Historic Places. The farm owners say they were given only a few months notice that their land would be taken, but that TVA has been planning this for several years.

National & World News

- ◆ Thousands of mourners stood by railroad tracks in Texas Thursday to honor President George H.W. Bush as his funeral train carried his casket to his final resting place at Texas A&M University. The engineer and conductor were two veterans who served in the Navy just as he did.
- ◆ A veteran Georgia police officer was shot in the face Thursday morning and has been hospitalized in critical condition. The suspect shot at the police officer at a dentist's office according to Henry County Police Department Capt. Joey Smith. The injured officer managed to fire back, shooting the suspect. The suspect was shot at least once and has died.
- ◆ The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 79 points or 0.3% to 24.948.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The Tennessee Department of Transportation says the paving on Highway 305 is done for now. The contractor will come back in the spring and finish up anything that is left to do. As for South White Street (State Highway 30), the stripes have been painted on the new pavement on the lanes leading from Athens toward Etowah. TDOT says the plan is to switch traffic to the new lanes next week, possibly on Tuesday, Dec. 11th. If the contractor can't get it done then because of weather, it will be done as soon as possible after that date. At that point, work will begin on the lanes leading into Athens.

UNIQUE WEATHER PHENOMENON SPOTTED

Most folks have seen a rainbow or two in their lifetime, but have you ever seen an "ICE PRISM"? Newschannel 9 Senior Meteorologist Bill Race confirmed to the Morning Fax that the photo below contains an image of one. This was taken Wednesday morning at 8:21 a.m. from Depot Hill facing East. Race said the Cirrus cloud formation contained ice clouds, which caused the refraction of the sunlight into the colors normally seen through a prism. Cirrus clouds form at 25,000 feet or higher and are made of ice crystals.
