Remembering a Tragedy

Twenty-eight years ago today a major tragedy took place on Interstate 75 at the Calhoun exit number 36. Ninety-nine vehicles were involved in a chain-reaction crash in extremely dense fog. Several of the vehicles caught fire and burned. Twelve people died and 51 were injured. The disaster was blamed on the fog and involved 27 separate accidents. Soon after the wreck, the Tennessee Department of Transportation installed a fog detection system. When it is activated, drivers are alerted with warning signs, flashing lights, and lowered speed limits. The system even automatically lowers gates on the entrances to I-75 to prevent vehicles from getting onto the interstate. National News

- ◆ The man suspected of sexually assaulting and killing 13-yearold Hania Aguilar in North Carolina could face the death penalty if convicted. Michael McLellan, 34, is accused of abducting and killing Hania in November.
- ◆ French president Emmanuel Macron addressed the nation in a recorded TV speech on Monday and announced new economic measures in response to weeks of violent protests across the country due to increases in fuel taxes which Macron championed.
- ▲ A major winter storm that pummeled the Southeast has become a "nightmare and a tragedy" in North Carolina, claiming at least two lives. The storm has dropped staggering amounts of snow, ice and rain across North Carolina, with a year's worth of snow falling in some places in just one day.
- ◆ British Prime Minister Theresa May says she is calling off a key Brexit vote in Parliament scheduled for Tuesday that has been building for weeks amid increased infighting among politicians within and across all major political parties.

◆ FATAL TRUCK-PEDESTRIAN ACCIDENT

A pedestrian was killed early Monday morning in front of the McMinn County Justice Center on Highway 30 when he apparently stepped in front of a tractor trailer rig. Athens Police say the man was dressed in all dark clothing, was standing in the center two-way turn lane, and upon the approach of a truck he stepped in front of it and was struck. He was pronounced dead at the scene. Athens police are not releasing his name at this point pending notification of the next of kin.
