#### The Ground Shook in December

Nineteen earthquakes struck East Tennessee in December, according to the United State Geological Survey. Some of those quakes were actually "aftershocks," but all are categorized as earthquakes by the USGS. Quakes with magnitudes 1 to 2 are very minor. Earthquakes measuring 3 or higher are when people can really start to feel them. The Southern Appalachian Seismic Zone stretches from northeastern Alabama into East Tennessee and Southwest Virginia. It is considered to be one of the most active earthquake zones in the eastern United States, but most of the tremors are small. The biggest quake in East Tennessee this month was magnitude 4.4 near Decatur on December 12th.

#### ETOWAH RURAL TO GET NEW CHIEF

A change in leadership is coming to the Etowah Rural Fire De-



partment. The current chief, Brandon Frost, is stepping down effective January 1st. He will be replaced by Jeremy Harrison. Harrison is a deputy with the McMinn County Sheriff's Department and will now take on the additional responsibilities as chief of the Etowah Rural Fire Department.

- ◆ President Trump went to Al Asad Air Base in Iraq on Wednesday to meet with American troops. It was an unannounced visit and his first to an active combat zone since taking office in 2016.
