♦ NEW DIRECTOR FOR TENN. OVERHILL

National & World News

- ♦ On day six of a partial government shutdown, negotiations among Democrats, Republicans and the White House are going nowhere. The Senate was expected to be in session Thursday to continue negotiations, but lawmakers didn't show up. The Senate was in session for a grand total of four minutes Thursday. Lawmakers aren't expected to be back in Washington until after the New Year next week.
- ♦ The number of law enforcement officers who died while in the line of duty went up in 2018 to 144 deaths. This is up from 129 deaths in 2017. The figures, released by the National Law Enforcement Officer's Memorial Fund, shows that the number of firearm deaths outpaced the number of traffic related deaths in 2018, with 52 officers dying because of gunshots and 50 dying as a result of a traffic incident.
- ♦ A storm system is moving into the Southeast with severe storms and snow to the north. The storm stretches from the Canadian border down to the Mexican border, with blizzard-like conditions from Kansas to Minnesota and strong storms with heavy rain from Texas to Illinois. Heavy rain and thunderstorms are also expected in the south from Alabama to the Carolinas. Flash flooding is possible in the region.
