◆ ALABAMA MAN KILLED IN I-75 WRECK


A Gadsden, Alabama, man was killed Monday afternoon in a one-vehicle wreck on I-75 at mile marker 59 in north McMinn County. State Trooper David Shannon says 24-year-old Kenton Ray Lacount was driving southbound on I-75 when his GMC Sierra pickup truck ran off the right side of the roadway. He over-corrected, coming back across both lanes of traffic before striking a guardrail. Trooper Shannon says that caused the vehicle to go airborne and strike a concrete bridge pillar. Lacount was dead on the scene. A passenger in the truck was injured.
