In addition, children ages 15 and younger may fish without a license tomorrow through next Friday, June 14th. Free Fishing Day applies to Tennessee's public waters, TWRA owned and operated lakes, and state park facilities.



1654 - Louis XIV was crowned King of France in Rheims.

1776 - Richard Henry Lee of Virginia proposed to the Continental Congress a resolution calling for a Declaration of Independence.

1848 - Postimpressionist painter Paul Gauguin was born in

1929 - Vatican City became a sovereign state as copies of the Lateran Treaty were exchanged in Rome.

1937 - The cover of *LIFE* magazine showed the latest in campus fashions of the times which included saddle shoes. 1939 - King George VI arrived at Niagara Falls, N.Y., from Canada on the first visit to the U.S. by a reigning British monarch.
