## VEC Has It's Hands Full

Volunteer Energy Cooperative crews worked virtually around the clock last Thursday and Friday to make repairs after an explosion and fire damaged two voltage regulators at the North Athens Substation on Ingleside Avenue in Athens. The explosion took place at 6:45 a.m. Thursday, knocking power off for 834 VEC customers. After several hours, repairs were made and the power was restored. The equipment malfunctioned again Thursday evening. Repairs were made again. The same thing happened Friday morning. This time, the decision was made to bring in new poles and equipment. Finally, at 5 p.m. Friday the power was reconnected and this time it worked.
