In economic news, initial jobless claims came in higher than expected last week. A separate report showed GDP first quarter was unchanged from the previous quarter. U.S. Treasury prices increased. Interest rates declined.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 10 points to 26,526. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 11 points or 0.4% to 2,925, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 58 points or 0.7% to 7.965.
