Fire Displaces Duplex Residents

Several families were displaced after a fire at a two-story apartment building on Hilltop Drive at County Road 177 just outside the Athens City Limits. The fire broke out around 2:30 Thursday morning. The Athens Fire Department responded first, and when they realized it was outside the city they also alerted county fire units. Athens Rural, Niota Rural, and Clearwater fire departments all responded. Athens Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth says it was a two-story duplex containing six living units. He says by the time firefighters arrived, the fire had consumed most of the second

floor. Chief Ainsworth says the ground floor received smoke and water damage. No one was injured, and the Red Cross was



notified to assist the displaced families. Chief Ainsworth says Million Street was closed for several hours because firefighters had to run one-thousand feet of hose from the hydrant.
