- ✓ Athens Utilities Board will be flushing water hydrants around the city today. Unlike in past years, much of the flushing will take place during daylight hours. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says the flushing will start at 12:30 p.m. and the work should be finished by early evening. He says two major advantages of doing the work earlier are worker safety and the workers' ability to observe water clarity as they flush the system.
- ✓ Saturday, October 26th,is the National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. Starr Regional Medical Center encourages community members to bring any unused or expired prescription mediations (pills or patches only) to one of the following drop-off sites in our community to safely dispose of them: Athens Police Department, Walgreen's Pharmacy at 1302 S. Congress Parkway, and Walmart Pharmacy.
- ✓ The forestry department has resumed issuing burn permits as a result of the rain and cooler weather. The burn ban has also been lifted in the City of Athens. However you still must call the Athens Fire Department and obtain permission.
