Arson, Murder, and Mayhem

McMinn County deputies responded to a domestic disturbance call around 5 p.m. Friday on County Road 288, near Niota. They discov-

around 5 p.m. Friday on County Road 288, near Niota. They discovered a male holding a female hostage in a home, which he had set on fire. Another home nearby was also set on fire as well as a vehicle that was used to block the entrance to the property. The woman, identified as Dawn Branson, attempted to escape from the burning house and was apparently shot to death by her husband, 59-year old Roger L. Branson. McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy said that deputies attempted to negotiate with Branson, but he refused to cooperate. Deputies encountered Branson at the back of the residence, where he fired shots at them. Deputies returned fire, striking him. Branson was trans-



striking him. Branson was transported to a hospital for treatment. Sheriff Guy says that none of the deputies were injured. Rural fire departments from District 1, 2, 9, and 10 were called to the scene to extinguish the three fires. District Attorney General Steve Crump, requested that the TBI investigate the incident.
