SRH&R Earns Five Stars

Starr Regional Health & Rehabilitation has been awarded five stars in the Nursing Home Five-Star Quality Rating System published on the Nursing Home Compare website by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. Nursing homes with five stars are considered to have much above average quality. The five-star rating places the facility in the top 17 percent of all nursing homes in the state with respect to health inspections, staffing and quality measures. Only 54 of the 316 nursing homes in Tennessee rated received five stars. Starr Regional is the only five-star rated facility within a 25-mile radius of its location.
