Another Black History Moment

Lewis Curtis agreed to come to Athens to teach for one year at J.L. Cook School. Thirty-eight years later, Lewis was still there and heavily involved in community activities. His areas of service ranged from education to agriculture to church and civic clubs. His philoso-

phy was "keep it short and simple, serve by example."

It is an example McMinn County might have missed had it not been for Principal E. Harper Johnson of J..L. Cook School, whose "arm-twisting" convinced Curtis to come to Athens. Lewis, a graduate of Tennessee State University, was working at the Y-



12 plant in Oak Ridge and continuing his education when Principal Johnson invited him to become a member of the faculty at the Athens school in 1956.

After Curtis had agreed and Johnson had obtained the local school board's approval, Curtis changed his mind. Johnson called him and said, "Don't do me like that. I'm a man of my word and I thought you were too." Curtis replied, "Okay, I'll come for one year." As fate would have it, he was at Cook school as a teacher and coach for many years.
