A Moment of Black History

Dr. Charles J. Montgomery operated a dental office on Tennessee Avenue in downtown Etowah for a number of years. His dental assistant was an African-American woman, Mrs. Virginia Williams Taylor. She was born in Buckhead, GA, in 1906. The family moved to Etowah, where her father and brothers worked in the L&N Railroad shops. Her husband, Leo, worked for the Glennora Hotel on the corner of Tennessee and

6th. He transported guests to and from the railway station. He also drove his wife to and from her job every day at the dentist's office. She would always sit in the backseat of her husband's car. Although Mrs. Taylor worked in Dr. Montgomery's office for many years in the late 1940's through the 1960's before integration, many of the patients probably didn't know that Dr. Montgomery's dental assistant was a woman of color. Ann Boyd, who wrote



this article, says when she was a patient of Dr. Montgomery, even she did not know. The term "racial passing" was often used to describe the actions of people of color of mixed racial heritage who chose to assimilate into white society in order to escape racial discrimination.

✓ The Athens City Council held its monthly meeting Tuesday night. At the meeting, Police Chief Cliff Couch reported there were 58 thefts in Athens in January, 15 assaults, 10 burglaries, 9 motor vehicle thefts, and 2 sex offenses. Officers issued citations for 231 moving violations. There were 53 traffic accidents in January, with 7 injuries. Chief Couch reported there are 3 vacancies on the police force. Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth reported that firefighters responded to 152 calls in January. There were 5 calls to fires, 117 calls for rescue and emergency service, and 18 false alarms. Losses from fires for the month totaled \$8,000.00.
