- The McMinn County Commission's Emergency Services Committee will meet on Monday, Feb. 22nd, at 6 p.m. in the Blue Room of the Courthouse. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss fire hydrant requests, truck replacement, communications update, and the AMR contract.

#### **State Headlines**

- Dolly Parton has asked state leaders to withdraw a bill to have a statue of her placed on the Tennessee State Capitol ground. Dolly says she is "honored and humbled" by the intention of lawmakers, but believes the move is not appropriate at this time. The country legend says years from now if the Legislature feels she still deserves the honor, she would stand proud as a grateful Tennessean in the Capitol.
- ✓ More than one million unemployment claims have been filed in Tennessee since the pandemic broke out in March of last year. The latest week-to-week Tennessee unemployment claims and continuing claims have decreased slightly. Last week, the Tennessee Department of Labor reported 8,110 new claims were filed in the state. That's the lowest number of new claims since December 26th.
- ✓ A nine-year-old boy has died after a sledding accident in Brentwood. Police say the child was riding on a tube, along with three other children, being pulled down a road by an ATV that was driven by the boy's father. As the tube was sliding through the snow and ice, it collided with a mailbox, critically injuring the nine-vear-old. He died at Vanderbilt University Medical Center. The three other children were not hurt.
