

One More Moment of Black History

Black History Month is over, but we wanted to recognize one more person who played a major role in the Athens community.

He was W.E. Burke, who was born in North Carolina and moved to Athens in 1962. He was married to Mozella and was the father of seven children. He served in the Navy during the Korean Conflict and was a member of the National Guard. He was one of the organizers of the first African-American Boy Scout Troop in Athens. He had served as an auxiliary police officer for the City of Athens. He also owned Burke's Record Shop in Downtown Athens, Downtown 76

gas station on White Street, and Burke's Garage. He sang in the choir of Greater Mt. Pleasant Baptist Church. His love of music inspired him to start the Gospel Jubilee Radio Program which has been aired on Sunday mornings on WYXI Radio since 1967 and remains on the air to this day. W.E. Burke passed away on August 14, 2005.

This is the second bill involving Dolly to be introduced in the legislative session. The first called for a statue of Dolly on the state capitol grounds.
