✓ The playground at Cook Park will be closed to the public until further notice. The closure is due to damage that occurred on Wednesday caused by an automobile incident. The Parks Department says the closed area is fenced and marked with "area closed" signs. The area is unsafe to enter due to structural issues and citizens must stay outside the fenced areas for their own safety. The remainder of the park remains open. Parks Director Austin Fesmire says this will be an extended closure while they go through the process of certifying the condition of the equipment to make sure it is safe.

Remembering the Blizzard!

March 13th, marks the 28th anniversary of the "Blizzard of '93." About 19 inches of snow fell overnight on March 13th, 1993. Roads were impassible, people were stranded in their homes for several days, and electricity was out for up to a week for some residents in the Athens area. The weight of the snow destroyed several barns and chicken houses. All this happened in the days before cellphone cameras and Facebook. Cable TV was completely dead and many telephones were offline. The only major source of information came from battery operated radios listing to WYXI, WJSQ, and WLAR, which simulcast news coverage of road conditions, power outages, emergency rescue efforts, information about shelter, and live phone calls from citizens describing their situation. The National Guard was activated to help rescue people who were stranded in their homes. The photo below gives some idea of the amount of snow that fell.
