Meet Lola Belle Scott

As we continue to spotlight notable McMinn County women during National Women's History month, today we learn about the late Lola Belle Scott. She was born in 1917. After attending college, she

began her teaching career at Poplar Hill School, a one room school on Cedar Springs Road. She was the teacher, principal, and the janitor. Her daughter, Ann Davis, recalls that the government would send cans of pork 'n beans which Lola Belle would heat on the wood stove. During World War II, she worked as a nurse at Foree Hospital. After the war ended, she taught at North City School until



her retirement. She continued to teach in Adult Basic Education until she was 89 years old. She also taught many years at the McMinn County Jail and would have pizza for the students when they finished their course work.
