

TENNESSEE NEWS HEADLINES

- The Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt University Medical Center and the Meharry Medical College, both in Nashville, are starting pediatric COVID-19 vaccine trials. Vanderbilt will enroll at least 100 healthy kids from the ages of 6 months to 11 years old for the new pediatric Moderna vaccine trial.
- State lawmakers are debating a bill that would ensure people convicted of violent crimes against women or children will have to serve their full time behind bars. The "Truth in Sentencing" bill would keep offenders of rape, sexual assault or other violent crimes from getting out of prison early.
- A bill requiring either the cremation or burial of aborted babies has passed a state house subcommittee. It would require the woman or the abortion facility to pay for the process.
