The USDA Forest Service will be conducting prescribed burns in the Tellico and Ocoee Ranger Districts. Prescribed burns reduce the threat of wildfires by removing vegetation that accumulates and creates a fire hazard. Depending on weather, more burns will be held.

✓ Tennessee now has over a million residents who have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and 22% of Tennessee residents have received at least one dose of the vaccine.

✓ The Tennessee Department of Correction will resume inmate visitation on Saturday, April 10th. TDOC stopped visitations in March of 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Visitors will be required to wear masks, have their temperatures checked and respond to a series of COVID-19 screening questions prior to entry.
