Meigs Co. Takes COVID Shots Seriously

Figures from the Tennessee Department of Health show that 39.3% of the population in Meigs County have gotten the COVID -19 vaccine. For Meigs residents over age 65, 93.2% have been vaccinated. The numbers in McMinn County are much lower. Only 22.3% of the population have been vaccinated. The numbers are higher for the 65+ age group--55.6% have gotten their shots. Meigs County has also had the lowest number of cases of the virus of any county in Southeast Tennessee and currently has the lowest number of active cases of any county.

SCHOOL TEXTBOOKS NOW ONLINE

State Senator Mike Bell of Riceville and State Rep. Mark Cochran of Englewood successfully guided passage of legislation increasing transparency in public school educational material. The bill passed unanimously in the House and Senate chambers and was signed by the governor. The bill, known as the "Textbook Transparency Act," ensures all textbooks that are in the hands of Tennessee students are accessible for the public to view. It makes available online textbooks that are adopted by the state of Tennessee and used by public schools. Currently textbooks are required to be available to the public for review for 90 days. This legislation requires publishers to make these materials available as long as they are actively being used in the classroom.
