- ✓ Athens Utilities Board power division crews will be upgrading the power supply along County Road 250 next Monday, June 14th. The work will require a lengthy power outage and will make traffic detours necessary. The power outage will affect 156 AUB customers from 8:30 a.m. until roughly 2:30 p.m. The road closure will be from the intersections of County Roads 250 and 255 on one end to County Roads 250 and 264 on the other end. In the event of bad weather, the work will be delayed until June 15th.
- ✓ The Athens Public Works Department announces that the Eastbound lane on Longmill Road from Cedar Springs Road to Nocatula Place will be closed next Tuesday, June 15th, from 7 a.m. until 4 p.m. for road repairs. Flaggers will be in place.
- ✓ A Championship Rodeo and Wild West Show to benefit the Riceville Volunteer Fire Department will be held tonight and tomorrow night at 8 at the covered arena in Athens Regional Park.

Nashville Mayor John Cooper has announced on Twitter an incentive program to encourage residents to get a COVID-19 vaccination. The new program is called "Shots on Goal" and will encourage everyone to be vaccinated in order for the city to reach its goal of "herd immunity." Vaccine recipients will receive a free coupon booklet that has almost a dozen different vouchers worth a total value of \$100. The booklets will be given away at pop-up clinics between now and June 30th. (Note: at Fax Time the Tennessee Health Department had not updated their stats)
