Motorcyclist Killed On Hwy 307

An Athens man, 27-year-old Zachary Holden, was killed early Wednesday morning in a collision between his 2012 Honda motorcycle and a pickup truck. It happened around 4:30 a.m. on Highway 307 at County Rd 364. The THP says Holden was going north on Highway 307 and entered a right-hand curve. At that point, the bike traveled across the center divider into the southbound lanes. striking a 2005 Ford F-150 that was going south. Holden was killed. The truck driver was not injured. State Trooper Rodney Best investigated the accident. The Englewood and Niota Rural Fire Departments responded.


HEAT WAVE HITS EAST TENNESSEE

A heat wave is bringing temperatures in the mid to upper 90's to Southeast Tennessee. AUB says utility companies are under Step 10 in TVA's load curtailment program, meaning they turn off all unnecessary electric equipment at the utility. AUB spokesman Wayne Scarbrough says he expects TVA to go to Step 20, which is an appeal to the public to also cut off any unnecessary electrical equipment, especially between 2 and 6 p.m. Scarbrough says washing dishes and clothes in the morning or at night can help, along with bumping up the thermostat a bit to use less air conditioning.
