Another Fatality On Interstate 75

A 2-vehicle collision around 5 a.m. Saturday claimed the life of 64-year-old Mitchell Allmon of Hixon. The wreck happened at the 37 mile-marker on the southbound side near the Calhoun exit. According to the THP preliminary report, 18 year-old Dylan Meadows of Webster, Ohio, driving a Ford F-150, swerved into the next lane to avoid hitting a tree that had fallen in his lane of travel. Allmon, who was driving a Western Star truck, hit the rear of Meadows pickup, sending it into the median, where it came to rest. Allmon's larger truck traveled off the right side of the road-way, up an embankment and into the woods where it came to rest. Allmon succumbed to his injuries on the scene. The THP report stated that Allmon was not wearing any safety restraints. Mead-ows had 3 other passengers in the F-150; a juvenile and 2 adults. The juvenile was not injured, however both adults were injured. No charges were listed on the report.
