Fatal Motorcycle Wreck in Athens

There was a fatal motorcycle accident in Athens this past Saturday night. The Tennessee Highway Patrol says it happened at West Madison Avenue and Stanton Lane around 9:25 p.m. The THP says a 2021 Kia Optima was traveling on West Madison Ave. and attempted to make a left turn onto Stanton Lane when the driver pulled in front of a motorcycle which was traveling on Stanton Lane. The operator of the motorcycle was killed. He was identified as Gene Arnwine, 32, of Athens. A small child riding in the Kia Optima was injured. The THP says charges against the driver of the Kia are pending.

MyRide McMinn is a senior-friendly volunteer transportation service made possible with the support of volunteer drivers who use their personal vehicles to carry McMinn County seniors to a variety of destinations, including medical appointments, banks, grocery and drug stores. Riders will pay a \$25 annual membership fee and then pay a small fee for the first round trip and one-dollar for each additional stop. There will be a scholarship program for seniors in need.
