Census Shows Slow Growth in McMinn

The 2020 Census figures show McMinn County's population grew by only 1,010 people from 2010 to 2020. That's an increase of about 101 people per year, or 1.9% The 2020 Census shows McMinn's population is 53,276. The McMinn County population growth was the lowest of any county in Southeast Tennessee.

The population grew by 9.8% in Bradley County. Bradley's population now stands at 108,620.

Meigs County's population increased by 8.6% from 2010 to 2020. The Meigs County population according to the 2020 census is 12,758.

The population of Polk County went up by 4.3% during the 10 years from 2010 to 2020. Polk County's population is 17,544.

In Monroe County, the population increase was 3.9%, and now stands at 46,250.

Rhea County's population grew by 3.3%, and is now listed as 32,370.


