To date, there have been 17 boating-related fatalities in Tennessee.

Thursday's Market Report

Equities finished modestly higher but with a sense of hesitation as investors await Friday's August jobs report. Global markets were mixed. Action in the bond market was similarly subdued with little change in 10-year yields. Jobless claims showed a decline to 340,000, the lowest since the pandemic began. ADP expects job growth and unemployment to continue their path of gradual improvement through the remainder of 2021.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 131.29 to 35,443.82. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 12.86 to 4,536.95, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 21.80 points to 15,331.18.
