Polk Co. Man Charged With Murder

A Polk County man has been arrested and charged in connection with the murder of his neighbor earlier this week. At the request of

10th District Attorney General Stephen Crump, TBI agents began working alongside the Polk County Sheriff's Office to investigate the death of a man shortly after deputies found his remains on Fingerboard Road. During the investigation, authorities developed information leading to Mitchell Edward Mingie, 58, as the person responsible for killing the man and improperly dispos-




ing of his remains. He has been charged with one count of Second-Degree Murder and one count of Abuse of a Corpse. The name of the victim has not been released at this time because the next of kin has not been properly notified.
