THURSDAY'S MARKET REDORT: U.S. equity markets closed mixed. The S&P 500 and Nasdaq outperformed the Dow. The U.S. 10-year yield fell notably, down now to 1.52%.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 33.35 to 36,124.23. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 19.49 to 4,680.06, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 128.72 points to 15,940.31.
