U.S. equity markets closed higher. Yields continue to climb higher. The 10-year Treasury yield is now close to 1.64%, and the U.S. dollar index also climbed to a new 52-week high, above 95 levels. Crude oil prices are holding steady, with WTI still above \$80. Gold prices were slightly down. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 54.77 to 36,142.22. The S&P 500 was up 18.10 to 4,700.90, and the NASDAQ was up 120.01 to 15,973.86.
