SHERIFF JOE GUY TO SEEK RE-ELECTION

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy has announced his candidacy for a fourth term as the Republican candidate for McMinn County Sheriff. Guy has served as Sheriff since 2010. Before that, he served 8 years as an Assistant to the McMinn County Mayor. Prior to that, he worked as an officer for the Englewood and Etowah Police Departments, as an EMT, and as a deputy with the McMinn County Sheriff's Office where he was also a supervisor, a School Resource Officer, and SWAT Team Commander. Sheriff Guy says if re-elected he will continue to develop new strategies for fighting drug-related crime like burglaries and thefts and to continue to be aggressive on drugs and addiction, because that drives almost every other crime. Guy is also the McMinn County Historian.
