Changes in Covid Reporting

The TN Department of Health says in the year 2022, they will be changing the procedure for reporting COVID-19 cases. Instead of giving reports 5 days a week, the information will be reported on a weekly basis, consistent with other infectious diseases. The Department says 5,394,058 COVID tests were processed this year. The total number of cases reported was 762,964. The total number of vaccines administered this year was 8,280,246. The Department says death certificates listing COVID as an underlying cause of death from spring 2020 through Dec. 2021 totaled 20,644.
