- The Tennessee Highway Patrol will be conducting a sobriety check point New Year's Eve on Highway 11 at the McMinn-Bradley County line.
- ✓ The McMinn County Sheriff's Department will offer free Sober Rides on New Year's Eve. Call 745-3222 and an officer will give you a ride to your home or to a hotel room. They will not take you to another party.
- ✓ The CDC says the flu season has arrived on schedule after taking a year off. Last year's flu was the lowest on record. Dr. Jensen Hyde says most people didn't even get a cold last year because of masks, social distancing, etc. But she says we've let our guard down this year, and cases for both COVID and flu are rising. Both have similar symptoms-fever, chills, body aches and coughing. She says the goal is to get COVID-19 to a level like the flu where it occurs during a specific season and is predictable.

#### CLARIFICATION ON SOCIAL SECURITY CHECKS

In Wednesday's Morning Fax, we reported that Social Security checks will go up by 5.9% in 2022. However, we must point out that the premiums for Medicare Part A will go up by approximately \$15 per month and Medicare Part B premiums go up by nearly \$22 per month. That means the anticipated increase of Social Security payments of approximately \$92 per month will actually be only about \$55 per month. That should be able to pay for at least one tank of gasoline at current prices.
