Old Year Ends with Fatality

A Chattanooga man was killed in a one-vehicle crash on Interstate 75 in McMinn County early last Friday, December 31st. The Tennessee Highway Patrol says Wayne Sellers, 35, was traveling northbound near mile marker 37 when his vehicle ran off the right side of the road. He over-corrected, and the car went back across the roadway into the median, where it struck a tree. Sellers was pronounced dead at the scene.

UNEMPLOYMENT DROPS IN SE TENNESSEE

The unemployment rate for November was down in 85 of Tennessee's 95 counties. Here in the Athens area:

McMinn County - The jobless rate for November was 3.3%, down from 3.4% in October.

Meigs County - Unemployment in November was 3.6%, unchanged from October.

Monroe County - Unemployment was 2.9% in November, down from 3.0% in Oct.

Rhea County - 3.8% in November, down from 4.1% in Oct. Polk County - 2.8% in November, down from 3.2% in Oct. Bradley County - 2.9% in November, down from 3.2% in Oct.
