- ✓ The McMinn County Board of Education and the McMinn County commission will have a joint Workshop Meeting on Monday, January 31st, at 6 p.m. at the McMinn County Center for Educational Excellence. The McMinn County Schools Master Planning Proposal will be presented.
- ✓ The E.G.
