

Fire Leaves Families Homeless

The Athens Fire Department responded to an apartment complex fire at Athens Mews Apartments on Garden Drive Monday at approximately 10:00 p.m. The Athens Fire Department arrived on the scene at approximately 10:03 p.m. Battalion 2 established command and requested a full page with an off-duty response. Occupants in the front yard stated one of the apartments might still have someone inside. The door was secured on the secondfloor apartment and firemen made a forced entry to get inside. Upon entry, crews were met with heavy black smoke conditions with the fire found just a few feet inside the door. The fire was quickly extinguished and a full primary search was conducted. A tenant was discovered inside the hallway and was removed from the apartment and delivered to a waiting AMR ambulance and EMS personnel. A secondary search was made and no other occupants were found in the apartment. A check for other fires was made throughout the apartment and the apartment next door and no other fires were found. Two additional families from the firstfloor apartments were displaced. The injured tenant, who was the only occupant of the apartment, was airlifted to the UT Medical Center with life threatening injuries. The cause of the fire is currently under investigation. Athens Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth stated: "We extend our thoughts and prayers to the family affected by this fire, I am very proud of the quick response and work by all of the agencies in protecting life and property in this case."

The price of regular unleaded in Chattanooga this week is \$3.07. In Knoxville, it is \$3.05. Here in the Athens area, gas can be found for 2.92 to 2.99 per gallon.
