

# Police & Fire Activity for Jan.

The Athens City Council heard the reports for activity in January from the police and fire departments at their Tuesday night meet-

Interim Police Chief Fred Schultz reported there were 37 thefts in January, 20 assaults, 10 motor vehicle thefts, and 8 burglaries. Officers issued 62 citations and 56 warnings for moving violations. There were 75 traffic accidents in January, with 8 injuries. There are currently 6 vacancies on the police department.

Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth reported that the fire department responded to 201 calls in January. There were 8 fires, 11 false alarms, and 152 calls for rescue & emergency service. He also reported that the two new engines have arrived. Property losses in January totaled \$144.000. Most of that (\$125,000) was from a building fire on January 31st.

### PROPERTY TAX DEADLINE DRAWING CLOSER

Monday, Feb. 28th, is the last day to pay property taxes before interest and penalty must be added. The McMinn County Trustee Office will be open from 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon every Saturday in February and Monday-Friday from 8 to 4. The law requires the Trustee to send unpaid "business personal property" taxes and 2020 delinquent taxes to Chancery Court on March 31st. City property taxes are also due by February 28th. They can be paid at the finance office at the Athens Municipal Building.

The Southeast Tennessee Human Resource (SETHRA) will be distributing UDSA commodities to eligible McMinn County residents on Thursday, March 17th, from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Athens Regional Park Expo Center. You do not need a commodity card to participate. But if you have not been issued a card since Oct. 1st, 2021, you will need to provide proof of income for all household members or proof of category eligibility to participate. Eligibility will be based on total income not in excess of the state-established maximum.


