Hidden Camera Found at School

A Middle School teacher in Cleveland is accused of putting a hidden camera in a girls' locker-room. A student at the Cleveland Middle School discovered the camera and informed school officials who then notified the School Resource Officer. The SRO contacted Cleveland Police Department supervisors and their Criminal Investigations Division. Cleveland Police officials and investigators went to the school and began conducting interviews. Less than 24 hours later, Cleveland Middle School teacher Christopher Schroll was arrested. Schroll was charged with Attempted Aggravated Unlawful Photography of a minor which is a felony.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT:

Markets closed sizably higher for the 3rd day in a row. Russian officials pushed back on the narrative that Ukrainian/Russian talks are making progress towards peace. A quickly changing situation in Ukraine has added volatility to markets. U.S. 10-year yields moved higher throughout the day and closed at the 2.2% mark. Oil prices moved sharply higher to \$103 a barrel. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 417.66 to 34,480.76. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 53.81 to 4,411.67, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 178.23 points to 13,614.78.

A 2002 Jeep Liberty, house and nearby woods caught fire on County Road 875 near Etowah. It happened Monday around 11:30 a.m. destroying both the house and Jeep. The owner stated the fire started behind the cook stove and he tried to put it out but it spread too quickly. 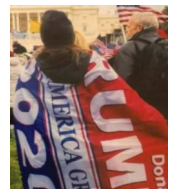

1963 - The U.S. Supreme Court, in Gideon v. Wainwright, ruled unanimously that state courts were required to provide legal counsel to criminal defendants who could not afford to hire an attorney on their own.
