Power To Cost More in April

The April power rate was expected to go down as the first of two "transition" months kick in across the valley. But TVA's fuel cost adjustment is rising, so much, as to push the final power rate up in comparison. AUB is lowering its base rate in April from \$0.07088 down to \$0.06887 per kilowatt hour. But TVA's fuel cost is rising in April, up to \$0.02446 from \$0.02134 currently. "This TVA charge will push the power rate up a bit in April compared to March. With April being a transition month where AUB's base rate is the lowest of the year, we fully expected the overall rate to be lower," said AUB's Wayne Scarbrough. "But, where our base rate falls in April, the rising TVA fuel cost causes our April effective rate to be \$0.09333, which is up a bit from the March rate of \$0.09222."

MONDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equities took a breather following a 6% gain last week, the S&P 500's strongest weekly gain since late 2020. The S&P 500 finished the day unchanged. There were no major economic data releases. Commodity prices continued to see upward moves, particularly oil, which was notably higher amid reports that EU governments are mulling an embargo on Russian crude. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 201.94 to 34,552.99. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 1.94 to 4,461.18, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 55.38 points to 13,838.46.
