Wreck Claims Life of Etowah Woman

Janice Hawn, age 62, passed away last Sunday around 2:20 p.m. due to a vehicle crash on State Highway 163, the Bowater Road. She was a passenger in a 2017 Ford F-150 pickup truck being driven by Johnny Hawn, age 65, of Etowah, who was injured. According to the preliminary report from the Tennessee Highway Patrol, the pickup was traveling eastbound when it left the roadway to the right. It then went down an embankment and collided with a standing tree before coming to rest. Both passengers were wearing seat belts and no charges have been filed by the THP.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Major indexes were sharply negative, with comments from a Federal Reserve governor indicating tighter monetary policy ahead. The U.S. 10-year Treasury yield moved past 2.5%. On the international front, European stocks are sharply lower. The Federal Reserve is expected to release its meeting minutes, giving clarity to whether a 50-basis-point hike at the next meeting is in the cards. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 280.70 to 34,641.18. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 57.52 to 4,525.12, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 328.39 to 14,204.17.
