THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Equity markets rebounded with all three major averages closing in the green. Defensive sectors like health care and consumer staples led the way. Markets are still digesting the Federal Reserve minutes released Wednesday, where FOMC members discussed potentially raising rates by 0.50% in their May meeting. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 87.06 to 34,583.57. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 19.06 to 4,500.21, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 8.48 to 13,8997.30.
