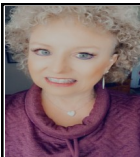

♦ **Bill J. Choate**, age 91, of the Goodsprings Community, near Etowah, passed away in Memphis on August 3, 2021. The family will hold a memorial service at the Goodsprings Baptist Church on Saturday, April 16th, at 2 p.m. with receiving of friends beginning at 1 p.m.

TODAY IN HISTORY - APR 14th

1775 - The first American society for the abolition of slavery was formed in Philadelphia.

1828 - Noah Webster copyrighted the first edition of his dictionary.

1861 - The flag of the Confederacy was raised over Fort Sumter, South Carolina, as Union troops there surrendered in the early days of the Civil War.

1865 - John Wilkes Booth crept into President Abraham Lincoln's box at Ford Theater in Washington and shot Mr. Lincoln. The President died the next morning.

1910 - President William Howard Taft became the first U.S. chief executive to throw the ceremonial first pitch at a baseball game as the Washington Senators beat the Philadelphia Athletics 3-0.

1912 - the British liner RMS Titanic collided with an iceberg in the North Atlantic at 11:40 p.m. ship's time and began sinking. (The ship went under two hours and 40 minutes later with the loss of 1,514 lives).

1935 - Country singer Loretta Lynn was born in Butcher Holler, Kentucky....a coal miner's daughter. She was one of eight children. She married at the age of 14 and eventually moved to Nashville. Her first top ten hit record was "Success" in 1962.

Wednesday's Market Report

Equities rebounded and major U.S. indexes were higher. Markets are attempting to rally. Inflation continues to weigh on investor sentiment and recent readings show no sign of price growth slowing. Oil is back above \$100 a barrel and moved higher Wednesday. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 344.23 to 34,564.59. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 49.14 to 4,446.59, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 272.02 to 13,643.59.
