A military honor flight is in the works for 77 veterans from our area who will be flown to Washington, DC to visit the War Memorials in the Nation's Capital. ## **TODAY IN HISTORY - APRIL 18<sup>th</sup>**

**1775** - Paul Revere began his ride from Charlestown to Lexington, Mass., warning American colonists that the British were coming.

**1923 -** The first baseball game was played at Yankee Stadium in the Bronx, with New York beating the Boston Red Sox 4-1.

**1942 -** An air squadron led by Lt. Col. James H. Doolittle raided Tokyo and other Japanese cities.

**1946** - The League of Nations went out of business.

**1949 -** The Irish Republic was proclaimed.

**1955 -** Physicist Albert Einstein died at age 76.

**1978** - The U.S. Senate approved the Panama Canal Treaty, providing for the complete turnover of control of the waterway to Panama on the last day of 1999.

**1983** - A suicide bomber killed 63 people, including 17 Americans, at the U.S. Embassy in Beirut, Lebanon.

**1989** - Thousands of Chinese students demanding democracy tried to storm Communist Party headquarters in Beijing.

**1999 -** Wayne Gretzky, the National Hockey League's all-time leading scorer, played his last professional game, at Madison Square Garden in New York.

# **TWU Hosts Math Contests**

Tennessee Wesleyan University hosted the annual Tennessee Mathematics Teachers Association (TMTA) Contest recently with 200 high school and advanced middle school students from the area in attendance.

The TMTA content, in its 64<sup>th</sup> year, consists of a timed test taken by each participant. While the students enjoyed lunch on the TWU campus and in downtown Athens, the tests were graded, and winners were announced in a ceremony afterwards. TWU President Dr. Harley Knowles presented the awards in Townsend Auditorium.

The event has been on a two-year hiatus due to COVID-19, with students returning for the first time since the fall of 2019. There are six competitions, Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Statistics, Precalculus, and Calculus. Below are the winners:
